



SAINT REPORT INSTRUCTIONS

Within the context of the Confirmation process, a custom exists where a candidate with a Christian baptismal name chooses an additional name for Confirmation. All Saint Mark Confirmation candidates are asked to choose the name of a Saint and to become familiar with the life and witness of this Saint.

1. Read the life of your Saint. List the title and author of your reference books at the end of your report. The Religious Education Office may have several books on the lives of the Saints which you could borrow. The internet can be a great resource as well!
2. In the *first paragraph*, state why you choose this Saint. A paragraph should have at least three to five good sentences.
3. In the *next three paragraphs*, summarize *in your own words* the life of the Saint.
4. The *fifth paragraph* is to describe at least three qualities you most admire in this Saint and how the Saint demonstrated these qualities.
5. In the *final paragraph*, explain your present plan for incorporating these qualities into your own life.
6. Be sure that your Report is typed and double-spaced. Please proofread for spelling, punctuation, and proper grammar. **DO NOT FORGET** to cite your sources on a separate page! **DO NOT PLAGIARIZE!**
7. Make an attractive cover with your Saint's Name and your Name.
