OUR MINISTRIES

❖ **Altar Servers**

Youth who are in the 4th grade or higher may sign up to serve at Mass.

- Training is required for this Ministry.
- Participants must have received the Sacrament of Holy Communion.

❖ **Altar Society**

This Ministry provides and maintains flowers for Liturgical Services, launders Altar linens and sews garments when necessary.

❖ **Deaf Sign Language**

The 9:00 AM Mass provides signing for deaf and hard of hearing.

❖ **Extraordinary Ministers of Communion**

Ministers of Communion assist the Celebrant in distributing the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

- Training is required for this Ministry.
- Participants must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion.
- May also serve the Eucharist to the homebound and nursing home residents (requires separate training).

- Extraordinary Ministers of Communion for Life Teen Mass must be a junior or senior in high school and/or attained the age of 16.

❖ **Spanish Mass**

Training is provided for Hispanic members to serve in Ministries at the Sunday 1:00 PM Mass.

❖ **Life Teen**

Teens are trained to serve in Ministries at the Life Teen Mass.

❖ **Ministry of Hospitality**

This Ministry consists of ushers who offer greetings, collect Offerings from the congregation, and provide assistance when needed.

❖ **Ministry of Music**

This Ministry includes an adult choir, children/youth choir, and Life Teen band. Any members who sing or play instruments are welcome to join.

- Scheduled practices are required.

❖ **Ministry of the Word**

This Ministry consists of Liturgical Ministers who must have clear speaking voices and be able to speak in front of a large group.

- Training is required for this Ministry.
- Participants must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion.
